BOOTH REGISTRATION APPLICATION

Booth Fee (10'x10'): \$50

- All booth vendors must complete, sign, and submit a registration application.
- No booths will be registered over the phone.
- Booth size is 10' x 10'. You may purchase more than one booth space.
- Cost per booth is \$50. Makes checks payable to the BCOABC.
- Booth set-up is on Friday, April 27, 2018, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. All booths must be completely set up by day's end.
- Booth vendors are required to furnish all materials, tables, electrical cords/adapters, and chairs.
- Booth area will be marked off and numbered with paint. Please do not infringe on your neighbors' spaces.
- No dividers will be provided for booths. You must supply your own.

- No vehicles can be left in the building during booth set-up. You can haul your materials in, quickly unload, and then remove the vehicle from the arena ASAP.
- Each exhibitor must keep spaces clean and exhibits in good order. Please provide a trash can if you are giving out samples that create a need for immediate waste disposal.
- No individual PA system or highly flammable materials or firearms will be permitted on the premises. Music or AV sound must not be audible more than 8 ft from the booth.
- The booth will be secured on Friday evening. However, the BCOABC is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
- Booths must remain assembled until end of the event on Sunday, April 29, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

- All booths must be completely dismantled and all materials removed by Monday, April 30, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. The arena will remain open until 7 p.m. on Sunday, April 29, 2018, to allow take-down by those needing to leave that day. The BCOABC will not be responsible for any items or materials left in the arena after that date.
- Booth placement in requested areas cannot be guaranteed. The BCOABC reserves the right to place booths in optimal locations to attract the attention of patrons.
- The BCOABC reserves the right to reject, remove, or prohibit in whole or part, any booth exhibitor and his/her representatives, with or without giving cause. If cause is not given, liability shall not exceed the return to the exhibitor the amount of the booth rental. If an exhibit is removed for violation of these rules or for any other reasons, no return of the rental fee will be made.
